Instructions on how to prepare the IWSP-2015 abstract

This exemplary abstract summarizes the main style and format requirements for IWSP-2015 submissions. The following structure should be applied: title, authors, affiliations, abstract body, and references. Please indicate on top the preferred presentation form (oral *or* poster).

Please set the title in bold. Underline the name of the presenting author. Identify different affiliations by consecutive numbers in superscripts. Enter the affiliations in a simple form, just indicating the institution, city and country, without the detailed postal address. Start each affiliation in a new line.

The abstract body should be limited to 1600 characters (including references). Please keep from complicating the textual structure of your abstract. Make sure that the notation is clear and all uncommon symbols or expressions are properly reproduced in a PDF version.

The references should be consecutively numbered in square brackets and listed at the bottom. Use the Applied Surface Science journal format for citations: volume (year) page [1]. Avoid a long list of authors by '*et al.*' abbreviation [2].
